### Preparation and Storage

#### Stability & Storage:

Lyophilized powders can be stably stored for over 12 months, while liquid products can be stored for 6-12 months at -80°C. For reconstituted protein solutions, the solution can be stored at -20°C to -80°C for at least 3 months. Please avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles and store products in aliquots.

Actual storage temperature shall be subject to the COA.

### Protein Background

V-set and immunoglobulin domain-containing protein 8(VSIG8) is a single-pass type I membrane protein. The mouse VSIG8 cDNA encodes 417 amino acids (aa) including a 21 aa signal sequence, a 241 aa extracellular domain (ECD) containing 2 Ig-like V-type (immunoglobulin-like) domains, a 21 aa transmembrane domain and a 134 aa cytoplasmic domain. The function of VSIG8 is not clear.

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
