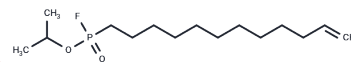

Biological Description

Description	Isopropyl dodec-11-enylfluorophosphonate (IDEFP) is an organophosphorus ester that serves as a central cannabinoid receptor (CB1) antagonist and equally inhibits fatty acid amide hydrolase (FAAH), both with an IC ₅₀ value of 2 nM [1].
