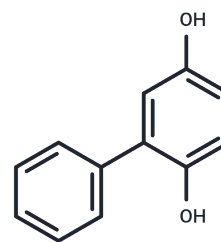

Description	2,5-Dihydroxybiphenyl (TFIIH Modulator12), a small molecule destabilization inducer, induces the dimerization of trichothiodystrophy group A protein to modulate TFIIH transcriptional activity.
