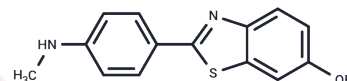

Description	PiB (Pittsburgh Compound-B) is a standard for analysis of <sup>11</sup> C-PiB. <sup>11</sup> C-PiB is a $\beta$ -amyloid PET imaging tracer for Alzheimer's disease diagnosis.

## Solubility Information

Solubility	DMSO: 62.5 mg/mL (243.84 mM),Sonication is recommended. (< 1 mg/ml refers to the product slightly soluble or insoluble)
In vivo Formulation	10% DMSO+40% PEG300+5% Tween 80+45% Saline: 6.25 mg/mL (24.38 mM),Suspension. 10% DMSO+90% Saline: < 6.25 mg/mL (24.38 mM),Lower concentrations may be soluble, but exact solubility limit is unknown. <i>Please add the solvents sequentially, clarifying the solution as much as possible before adding the next one. Dissolve by heating and/or sonication if necessary. Working solution is recommended to be prepared and used immediately. The formulation provided above is for reference purposes only. In vivo formulations may vary and should be modified based on specific experimental conditions.</i>
