Biological Description

Streptomycin-KLH is a hapten-carrier protein conjugate formed by coupling Streptomycin to keyhole limpet hemocyanin (KLH). As a hapten, Streptomycin alone cannot induce an immune response and must be conjugated to a large molecular protein to become a complete antigen with immunogenicity. Streptomycin-KLH may be supplied as a lyophilized powder or as a solution. The solution is prepared in 0.01M TBS (pH 7.4) buffer at a typical concentration of 1mg/mL.
