Biological Description

Description	Natrexone-BSA is a hapten-carrier protein conjugate formed by coupling Natrexone to bovine serum albumin (BSA). As a hapten, Natrexone alone cannot induce an immune response and must be conjugated to a large molecular protein to become a complete antigen with immunogenicity. Natrexone-BSA may be supplied as a lyophilized powder or as a solution. The solution is prepared in 0.01M PBS (pH 7.4) buffer at a typical concentration of 1mg/mL.
