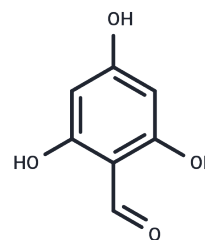

Biological Description

Description	2,4,6-Trihydroxybenzaldehyde is a natural product. 2,4,6-Trihydroxybenzaldehyde, a potential anti-obesity treatment, suppressed adipocyte differentiation in 3T3-L1 cells and fat accumulation induced by high-fat diet in C57BL/6 mice. It is also a potent antidiabetic agent. 2,4,6-Trihydroxybenzaldehyde has potential anticancer activity.

Solubility	DMSO: 50 mg/mL (324.42 mM),Sonication is recommended. (< 1 mg/ml refers to the product slightly soluble or insoluble)
In vivo Formulation	10% DMSO+40% PEG300+5% Tween 80+45% Saline: 2 mg/mL (12.98 mM),Sonication is recommended. <i>Please add the solvents sequentially, clarifying the solution as much as possible before adding the next one.
