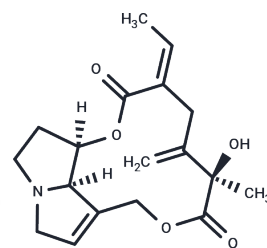


Seneciophylline

Biological Description

Description	Seneciophylline, one of the hepatotoxic pyrrolizidine alkaloids, has mutagenic activity in <i>Drosophila</i> and their transfer into rat milk. Seneciophylline can significantly increase the activities of epoxide hydrolase and glutathione-S-transferase but cause reduction of cytochrome P-450 and related monooxygenase activities.
Targets(IC50)	Cytochromes P450, GST
